

## Partner with Probation & Parole

### Open communication with both agencies, discuss weekly.

#### Joliet's Role

 Feed information (FI, suspect, arrest) to Probation on weekly basis

### Joliet's Role

- 1. Feed information (FI, suspect, arrest) to Parole
- 2. Coordinate sweeps of targeted offenders (based on activity and address) once a month

### Probation's Role

- 1. Process information provided by JPD
- 2. Attend weekly ABC meetings
- 3. Follow up, attempt to revoke

### Parole's Role


- 1. Process information provided by JPD
- 2. Attend ABC meetings
- 3. Follow up, attempt to revoke
- 4. Work with JPD on coordinated sweeps


Expected Result: Fewer shooters on the street

- Additional information and intelligence fed to officers
- Processing of intelligence received from the street
- Identify and track top offenders








# Focused Approach in Hotspots

- Focus on hotspots, implement various strategies BESIDES FLOODING AREAS, to include the following:
  - Offender-based patrol
  - Parole Sweeps
  - Targeting known offenders
  - Tracking current tensions & past altercations between gang members
  - Focused deterrence strategies with identified shooters.


#### Strategic Tactical Deployment Joliet, Illinois Police Department Logic Model




### **Evaluation**

- □ Time-series Analysis (ARIMA):
  - Estimate whether the implementation of STD produced an overall reduction in gun violence in Joliet, taking into account the weekly moving trends.
  - Analysis expanded to
    - Include pre-STD, STD only and STD + probation/parole
    - Include data since June 2005
  - Findings
    - there were no statistically significant effects of the intervention on violent crime (i.e., shots fired and robberies).


## Results - Shots Fired




# Results — Robberies

# Challenges

### **GOALS**

- Enhanced probation enforcement in STD areas.
  - Sweeps
  - Creation of special conditions
- Enhanced parole enforcement in STD areas.
  - Sweeps
  - Special cases i.e. homicide

### **PROBLEMS**

- County probation would not allow compliance checks.
- County juvenile probation would not cooperate.
- Unable to create special probation conditions.
- State reluctant to revoke parole w/o new arrest.
- Too few violent parolees in STD areas.
  - Program expanded citywide.
- Few special cases
